The Clinic and Seminar offers professional instruction by renowned International judge **Ms. Zara Pawley** BHS II, SM in judging protocol and guidelines for the planning and conducting of successful horse judging events.

The IHSI would like to emphasize the following:--

The Clinic and Seminars recommendation for judging and the organization of judging contests are based upon universal rules that have withstood the test of time irrespective of breed of horse. The IHSI respects the variations of breed types according to their geographical provenance but the essential judging criteria for the Indigenous breeds of India will be based upon the highest prevailing standards common to each breed.

The clinic and seminar will be divided into three days:-

Day 1 – The five key characteristics of judging.

- 1. Conformation and type
- 2. Quality
- 3. Sex and Gender characteristics
- 4. Action
- 5. Soundness and blemishes
- 6. Judging in hand and judging in performance

Day 2 –Solid foundation of format

- 1. Understanding comparative judging
- 2. How to use a score card
- 3. Allocating points to breed characteristics
 - 1. Anatomical accuracy
 - 2. Presenting oral reasons for judging classes
 - 3. Accuracy: the truth behind primary considerations in scoring
 - 4. Presentations, penalties and codes of conducts

Day 3 – Conducting a judging contest:--

- 1. Facilities
- 2. Horses and classes
- 3. Personnel
- 4. Preparing contest documentation: Score cards, certification, judges notes, registrations etc.

A mock judging contest will be set up on the grounds with aspiring contestants and judges using local horses. Ms. Zara Pawley will be judging the judges !!
